Walnut Corner Cabinet Chosen for Excellence in Design and Craftsmanship.

Carrollton, TX, November 22, 2019: Shell Woodcraft, a specialty wood products manufacturer, announced that its owner's latest design has received an award from the Majestic Ranch Arts Foundation for excellence in design and craftsmanship. The piece was entered and has been on display at the Texas Furniture Maker's Show in Kerrville, Texas along with over 50 other entries from Texas craftsmen. The cabinet is crafted from walnut solids & veneers. The arched opening highlights the shell which was inspired by European antiques and is composed of fifteen individually crafted hardwood pieces and a carved rosette. The curved back and shelves, which are adjustable, follow the shape of the shell. Corner cabinets add architectural interest and historical elegance to an otherwise unused space.

"Customers have requested that we add additional detail to our large shells," Frank Sigmund, owner of Shell Woodcraft noted. "I have incorporated the look of scallop shells into this corner cabinet. A piece like this has been hand-carved in the past and is a perfect place to proudly display your most prized possessions.

The bottom section of the cabinet has two shaker style doors with antique brass escutcheons and contains one additional shelf for storage. The piece is flanked by fluted columns topped with carved Corinthian capitals. Crown molding completes the design.
